Professor King was a prosecutor at the Nuremberg trials; Chief Counsel of the Agency for International Development; worked as chief corporate international counsel for TRW Inc., and as of counsel for Squire, Sanders & Dempsey LLP; headed the ABA's International Law Section; founded the Greater Cleveland International Lawyers Group; was appointed Honorary Consul of the Government of Canada for Northeastern Ohio; and served for the past 26 years as a Case Western Reserve University School of Law Professor and Chairman of our Canada-United States Law Institute.
